

Clear Improvement Across Key Risk and Safety Metrics

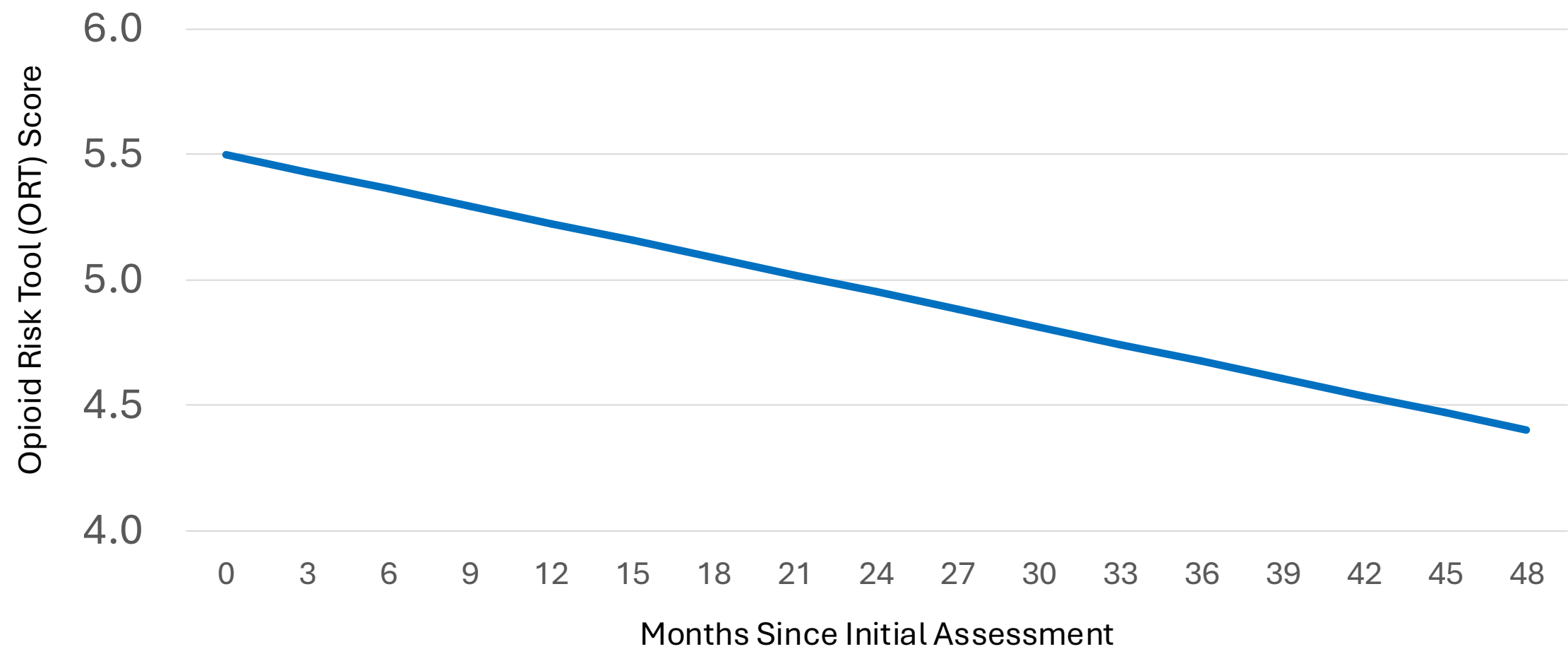
Metric	Baseline	After 48 Months
Compliance (flagged)	12-15%	2-5%
Naloxone gaps	35-40%	25-30%
ORT score	5.5	4.4

Significant Reduction in Opioid Misuse Risk Over Time

Opioid risk scores decline by ~20%

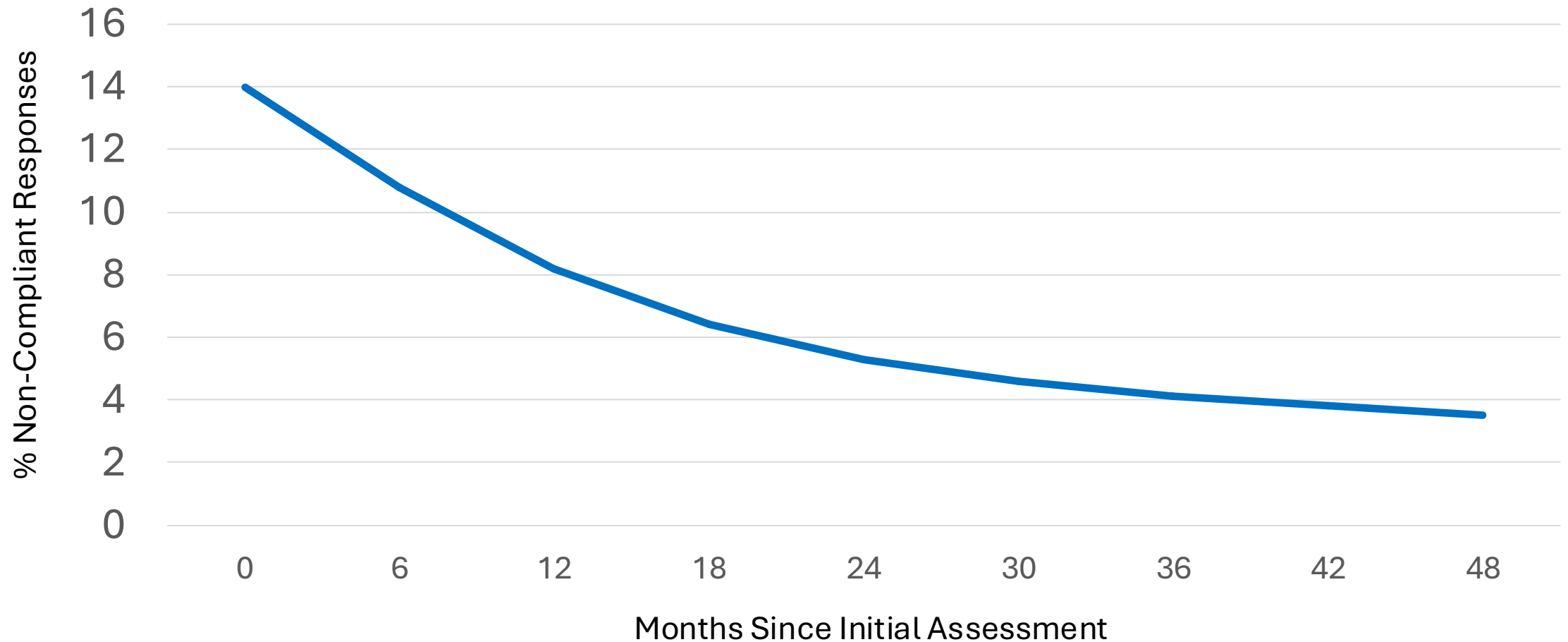


Model-implied trajectory based on longitudinal odds-ratio analysis of repeated patient assessments



Patients Become Significantly More Compliant Over Time

~75% reduction in non-compliance

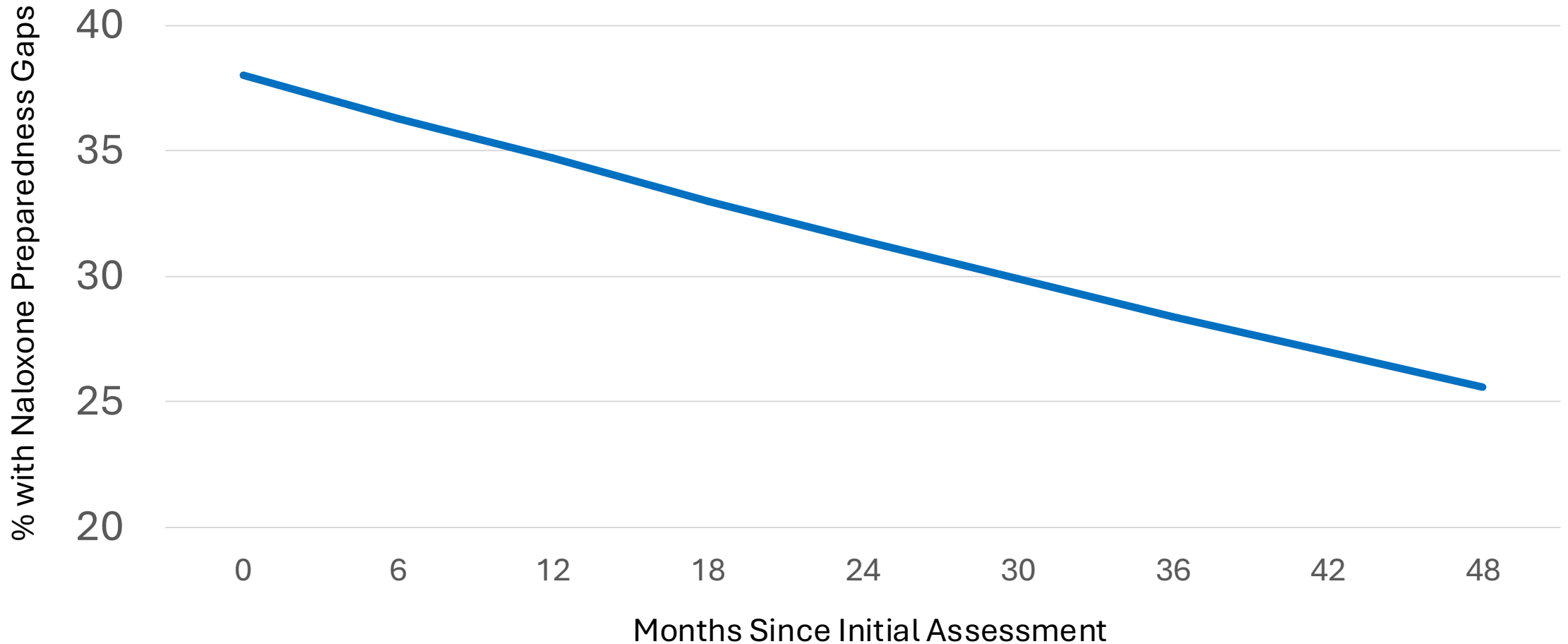


Model-implied trajectory based on longitudinal odds-ratio analysis of repeated patient assessments



Overdose Preparedness Improves Meaningfully Over Time

Naloxone preparedness gaps decline by ~33%
